- Spend a day acquainting yourself with the humanitarian efforts in South Africa; a guided uThando tour briefly implicates you in local community development programs.

Day 1: Cape Town

Land in historic Cape Town, South Africa and explore its narrow, restored streets, art galleries and surprisingly modern conveniences. Not to be missed are the parliament buildings, Company Gardens and abundant activity along Kloof Street.

Day 2: Table Mountain

Wake up refreshed, then enjoy the ride to Table Mountain, where a cable car will bring you to the top for a breathtaking view of the city and peninsula below. Try counting the hydraxes—or "rock rabbits"—with the kids; they're up here in abundance! On the way down, stop at the Spier Wine Estate for a picnic lunch, then come face to face with a domesticated cheetah at the Cheetah Outreach Programme. After this whirlwind of an afternoon, you can spend the evening as you see fit.

Day 3: Simon's Town

This naval hamlet located on the False Bay coast is teeming with activity for you and your family. Try your hands (and shoulders and forearms) at sea kayaking on the waterfront, visit with penguins on a private beach while taking in a cool drink, spot right whales off of Cape Town's shores, experience a local ostrich farm or take a bike ride around the whole darn thing; the trails here are fantastic. Today's itinerary is of a more human interest. You will travel alongside representatives from uThando, a South African charity which focuses on community outreach and social development programs in the Cape Town area. Day 5: Hermanus

Spend the morning in Hermanus: a whaling station that was settled in the 1800s; It is currently known as the best land-based whalewatching station in the world. Southern right whales visit Walker Bay from June through to December, when the world's only "whale crier" alerts the town of his presence, by way of his kelp horn. The Hermanus Wine Wander, an oenological adventure found in nearby Hemel, is highly recommended.

Day 6–8: Hermanus — Madikwe Game Reserve

Situated in the malaria-free zone of the North West Province, this "Big Five" reserve spans 75,000 hectares and is home to such impressive beasts as the Madikwe lion, which is known to hunt such big game as giraffe and eland. Accommodations for the rest of your stay are found in Jaci's Safari Lodge, a privately-owned luxury game lodge built around an enormous, ancient termite mound—which is far cooler than it sounds! The kids will love spending time exploring the lodge, which has a children's play area.

Cape Cadogan Apartments

An extension of the Cape Cadogan Hotel, the apartments are an innovative collection of restored Cape houses on a quiet street, with a central dining and reception area. Grootbos Garden Lodge

Situated on the Grootbos Private Nature Reserve in the Gansbaai area, this award-winning reserve is home to the largest Milkwood Forests in the world. The lodge is set within the fynbos and forest-clad hills which overlook the whale-watching haven of Walker Bay.



Jaci's Safari Lodge

A privately owned luxury game lodge located in the 76,000 hectare, malaria-free "Big Five" Madikwe Game Reserve, bordering Botswana. Ideally situated under shady trees, near an active waterhole the lodge curves around a huge, ancient termite mound. There is a spacious lounge and dining area, an outdoor boma, a fully equipped gym and children's play area.
